

Drug Video Story Board

Assignment:

Congratulations you have become a successful movie director! Way to go! You have decided to write a screenplay on drugs that will be shown to the entire grade 8 population in the city of Surrey next year. You have recently watched multiple drug videos on the negative effects of drug use. These drug videos included information on general addiction and the effects of specific drugs.

With the information you have gained by watching these videos, your own research and your amazing creative ability as a movie director, you will complete a 6 frame story board that will inspire the next award winning documentary on drug abuse.

Requirements:

- Complete a 6 frame story board with detailed image and description for each
- The 6 story frames will be as follows with one frame for each: Setting, characters, necessary drug information, problem, resolution, conclusion
- Will focus on one drug (that we have learned about in class or that can be researched elsewhere)
- Uses information gained in class (if the drug was covered) and researched
- Presents the drug in a negative light (focuses on the negative effects of drug abuse)
- The storyboard is written with appropriate language and images
- The storyboard is age appropriate (presented at the grade 8 level)

Student descriptions are detailed and tell a story of drug abuse that has a clear resolution and conclusion (descriptions provides information about the specific drug being studied)						
Storyboard presents valid information about the drug being described (must present a minimum of 5 facts and can present up to 8 facts about drug abuse)
