## **Survivor**

This is a group activity and there are a few guidelines that must be followed:

- 1) Your entire group must be in an agreement on which 7 people you keep.
- Avoid arguing, listen to everyone's ideas be open-minded. Don't think you need to avoid disagreements, sometimes it leads to more insight
- 3) No voting, rock-paper-scissors, or flipping a coin etc. please
- 4) Have an explanation for each choice ready to share
- 5) You will write out your choices and be ready to present them to the class
- 6) Time permitting- add images and symbols to your paper
- 7) Have your group members' names on your sheet

- 9. An educational professor.
- 10. A high school student in Honours classes.
- 11. A famous athlete.
- 12. A world famous writer.
- 13. A high school student with learning disabilities.
- 14. A newborn baby.
- 15. An elementary student who speaks 3 languages.
